Life Insurance

NGAT pioneered the provision of life insurance to the Texas National Guard and is the designated **State Sponsored Life Insurance (SSLI)** program for the State of Texas. Active Guardsmen are eligible for low-cost group life insurance. Coverage is 24 hours a day, 365 days a year with no war or aviation exclusion. Purchase as little as \$10,000 for \$3.66 a month or as much as \$50,000 for \$17.00 per month. Dependent coverage is also available.



NGAT Life Insurance policies may be retained when you separate or retire from the Guard. Visit the NGAT website at www.ngat.org for additional information on the SSLI program.
