#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- 1. Completed application.
- 2. Recent educational transcripts. (high school, college, etc.)
- 3. High school applicants (Seniors) must include SAT or ACT scores.
- 4. College freshmen should include their high school transcripts with their application.
- 5. Undergraduate or Graduate students **MUST** include all college transcripts with their application.
- 6. Must include a <u>minimum of 3</u> Letters of recommendation from commanders, teachers, ministers, etc., <u>NOT RELATED</u> to the applicant.

# **MOST IMPORTANT - MUST BE INCLUDED**

- 7. Applicants **must submit an essay** with specific facts as to your desires to continue your education. This essay should include sufficient information to provide the Scholarship Selection Committee a "word picture" of you and reveal the hopes, ambitions and determination you possess to further your education and why.
- 8. Make photocopies of all the above and keep it for your files.

# WINNERS TO BE ANNOUNCED IN MID MARCH

Educational grants for attendance at a college or university will be awarded for one year to current members of the National Guard Association of Texas and/or their spouses, sons, or daughters. To be eligible for a National Guard Association of Texas (NGAT) scholarship, the applicant must be a current annual or life member of NGAT or the spouse or dependent son or daughter of a current annual or life NGAT member.

Current associate members and their dependents are not eligible for the scholarship program.
